



Air Quality

Recently, Chesterfield Township has been experiencing hours of poor air quality more frequently. We hold the health and safety of participants as a high priority in all programming. In compliance with Macomb County Health Department, the National Weather Service, and AirNow.gov, we will be staying up to date on changing weather conditions, including air quality alerts. Chesterfield Parks and Recreation will be using the following measures to determine outdoor program cancellations.

US Air Quality Index

Good (0-50)

Moderate (51-100)

Unhealthy for sensitive groups (101-150)

Unhealthy (151-200)

Very Unhealthy (201-300)

Hazardous (301-500)

Department Staff will be closely monitoring air quality during programming hours. At time of decision, we will be using the following scale to determine need for cancellation, reschedule, or accommodation to an indoor site. Changes to outdoor programming may be made at any time leading up to the program start time. At an index of 151 or above, outdoor programs will be cancelled. All registered participants will be informed of any changes to the planned activity.

Refunds will not be provided if an alternate location or make-up date is provided. Facility rentals including sports fields and pavilions will not be cancelled due to low air quality. Usages should be determined by the renting party after consideration for the current conditions. For any program or event, it is important for all participants to make a personal decision on participation in regards to potential health concerns.
