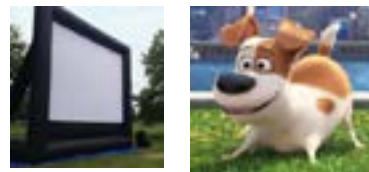

## Registration Procedures

- 1) Residents are individuals who live or own property in Chesterfield Township. Documentation may be requested (driver's license, tax bill or utility bill), if there is a question on the validity of residency status. Non-residents are encouraged to enroll, but in most cases pay an additional fee of \$5 per person, per program.
- 2) Registrations are accepted Monday-Friday, 8AM-4:30PM at the Dept. of Parks and Recreation located inside of the Chesterfield Township Municipal Offices at 47275 Sugarbush (Between Cotton and 21 Mile Road). Registration forms can be obtained on our website, [parks.chesterfieldtwp.org](http://parks.chesterfieldtwp.org). Registrations are also accepted online at, [parks.chesterfieldtwp.org](http://parks.chesterfieldtwp.org).
- 3) Walk-in registrations will be processed immediately. Registrations may be mailed to Chesterfield Township Parks and Recreation, 47275 Sugarbush, Chesterfield, MI. 48047. After hour registrations may be placed in the Drop Box located outside of the Chesterfield Township Municipal Offices using a personal check or money order. Both mail-in & drop box registrations will be processed when received by parks and recreation staff and may not be processed for several days. Mail-in & Drop Box registrations received prior to the first day of registration may be returned to sender.
- 4) Registrations must be accompanied by full payment, completed registration form(s), and participant or parent/guardian signature in order to be processed. Check, cash, VISA/MASTERCARD/DISCOVER accepted on site. Make checks payable to: Chesterfield Township. A 3% transaction fee (minimum \$2) will be added to all on-site credit card/debit card purchases made at the township. Registrations completed online at [parks.chesterfieldtwp.org](http://parks.chesterfieldtwp.org) incur a 2.5% transaction fee (minimum \$1.95). Register online and pay by VISA/MC and AMERICAN EXPRESS.
- 5) AGE GUIDELINES: For programs, participants must be the designated age or turning it during the program in order to participate. For leagues, participants' birthdates must coincide with designated age requirements. For programs & leagues using grade requirements, the participant must be in the designated grade when the program takes place. During summer break, a child should be enrolled in programs & leagues corresponding with the grade he/she will be entering in the fall. A child will not be permitted to participate if the above guidelines are not met. Our dept. reserves the right to request proof of age/grade.
- 6) Chesterfield Township Parks and Recreation reserves the right to cancel or change programs as necessary.
